CRITERIA

Applicants must meet and submit documentation of the following:

Obtain a Highly Effective IMPACT rating for cycle 1

Develop or contribute to School-Wide Practices to promote a positive learning environment

Engage in Family Collaboration Services to enhance educational outcomes

Demonstrate excellence in Data-Based Decision Making

Offer Preventive and Responsive Services to address student needs

Implement Interventions and Instructional Support to develop academic skills among students

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for the School Psychologist of the Year award, follow these steps before the specified deadline:

- Write a 2-3 page essay detailing why you should be named School Psychologist of the Year for SY 25-26.
- Include a comprehensive examination of your professional practices, outcomes, and contributions to the field of school psychology as outlined in the "Criteria" section.
- Secure a "Letter of Support" from a school leader or staff member

Application Deadline: All documentation must be submitted by Friday, May 15, 2026.
